How to link your child/ren to your My Health Account

If you have upgraded your account to identification level '**Complete'** you can add your child/ren to your My Health Account to view their immunisation records, COVID-19 test results and some NHI information on My Health Record.

To add your child:

- They must be under 12 years of age
- They must have a New Zealand birth certificate
- Your name must be on their birth certificate
- · You will need to have their birth certificate and NHI number

1) Select the 'Add children under 12' link on the 'I want to...' menu of My Health Record.
