Viewing your immunisation history

There are two identification levels in My Health Record, 'basic' and 'complete'. To access your wider health information, you need to have a 'complete' identification level. To obtain this, you will need to upgrade your My Health Account login for extra security.

To view your immunisation history, you can select '**view immunisations'** button on the My Health Record homepage, or by selecting **'immunisations'** in the navigation bar.

Viewing your immunisation history | Identification level 'basic'

With basic access you will have a **limited view** of My Health Record features. On immunisations page you can see your COVID-19 vaccine records only. If you would like to see all your available records, you will need to upgrade your account to 'Identification level: Complete'.

1) Your **immunisation record** will be displayed on the immunisations page.

2) You can also **request a PDF copy of your immunisation record** to be emailed to you.

3) Select the **drop-down arrow** to see additional information about your immunisations.

How to book a vaccine (Book My Vaccine Portal)

You can book vaccinations for yourself, someone else, or a group via the 'Book My Vaccine Portal' in their My health Record.

Do not worry if you are not sure what vaccines are due or need to be caught up on. When you arrive for the appointment your vaccinator will check for you.
